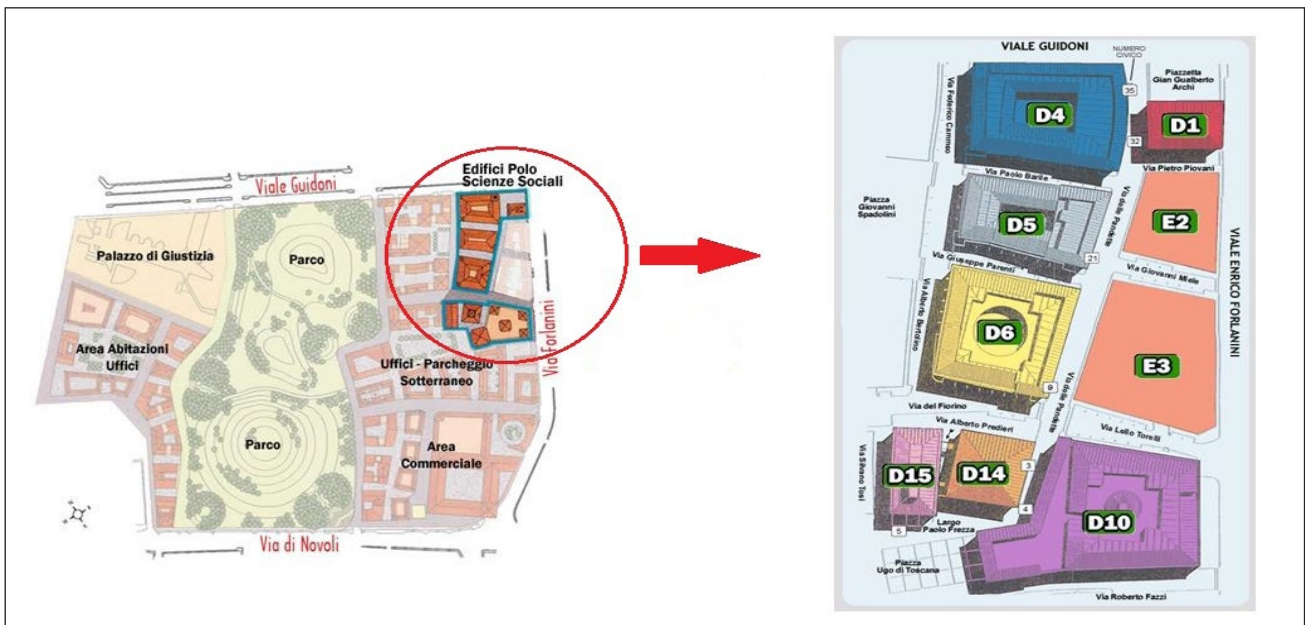

- From Peretola airport walk to the tramway stop called AEROPORTO Take the tramway Line T2 direction UNITA'
- Get of at SANDONATO stop (5 stops)

From Santa Maria Novella Station to Conference Venue:

- Take the tramway in via Luigi Alamanni (ALAMANNI stop) – Line T2 direction Airport
- Get of at SANDONATO stops (6 stops)
- Walk 530 meters towards Via delle Pandette



ABOUT FLORENCE

Florence, one of the most beautiful and visited art cities in the world, is an open-air museum, placed in the UNESCO's World Heritage List since 1982.

The Historic Centre of Florence attracts millions of tourists every year.

Florence's museums, palaces, and churches house represent some of the greatest artistic treasures in the world. The most popular and important sites in Florence to visit are the Cathedral, the Baptistery, the Uffizi Gallery, the Bargello and the Accademia. The churches of Santa Maria Novella and Santa Croce are veritable art galleries, and the library of San Lorenzo is a magnificent exhibition of Michelangelo's architectural genius. Here you can wander in some of the oldest streets in the city until you reach the Arno River, cross the Ponte Vecchio and experience the "newest" area of Florence, the Oltrarno. You can also spend a day at the Boboli Gardens or climb the hill to the church of San Miniato al Monte to experience an enchanting view of Florence.

Due to Florence's artistic and architectural heritage, it has been ranked by Forbes as one of the most beautiful cities in the world.



Local Transportation

Florence is a relatively small city; everything is at walking distance in the city centre. However, an extensive bus transportation net is available. Most of the bus stop at the main railway station and therefore near to the convention venue. Bus tickets can be purchased at most coffee bars and kiosks.

Tickets valid 90 minutes: 1,50 €

Tramway Ticket

To take the tramway it is mandatory to have a ticket in order not to incur penalties.

Ticket duration is 90 minutes from validation and are not available on board.

In all tramway stops there is an automatic ticket machine where you can only buy single tickets. The automatic machines accept Bancomat and Credit Cards from the Visa, Vpay, Maestro, Mastercard circuits (also with the contactless system). Tramway tickets and bus tickets are the same.

Taxis

Getting around the city by taxi is not difficult, but in Italy taxis cannot be flagged down as they pass along the street, taxis are instead “stationed” at special taxi parking stands in most of the major squares in any city and at the airport and they can be requested by phone.

Currency and Bank Services

The currency in Italy is Euro.

Banks are open from Monday to Friday, generally from 8:30am to 5:00pm. ATMs (cash machines) work 24 hours a day. All banks close down at weekends and on public holidays. There are plenty of currency exchange offices, banks and cash machines throughout the city.
